Our train station museum is on the piece of property located on El Camino Real and Serramonte Boulevard. Now the fun begins and we need all of your support. The restoration is a big job and many have volunteered their services but more hands are still needed. We hope we can begin the restoration in January or February and maybe have a grand opening in August 1994 on the 70th anniversary of Colma's Founding.

We were given five display cases that are now housed in the Town Hall. Two are in the conference room and three in the hallway. There is to be a separate theme for each case. Entitlements are: Police Memorabilia; Treasures in the Attic; Kitchen Work Tools around 1924 and earlier; Colma residents go to war (souvenirs) and Railroad memorabilia. Items loaned for display would be displayed for three months and then returned to the owner. We would, of course, be glad to receive things permanently as a deed of gift for our museum. The name of the person who bestows the item and the history of the item would also be displayed. Look thru your treasures and see if you have anything to show off and share.

Our first annual meeting will be Sunday, February 6, 1994 at 2:00 P.M. at Colma Town Hall. The board members now holding office are as follows: President, Pat Hatfield - 3 year term; Vice President Mary Brodzin - 2 year term; Secretary Alice Letcavage - 2 year term; Treasurer Dorothy Hillman - 3 year term; and Consultant Frances Liston - 1 year term. The Board Members know we could not have accomplished what we have without her knowledge and support, however, there will be an election and anyone who would like to hold this office should forward their name to Pat Hatfield by December 31, 1993. These names will be added to the ballot for the February election.
